



Guide to using the Picture My Future Library

- This picture library is designed to support people who are unable to collect their own pictures during the Picture My Future process. It has been developed using the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities as a guide.
- The pictures represent common domains that are important to people with disability including relationships, employment, training, housing, community access, hobbies and transport.
- The picture library can be used as a tool to prompt discussion about what is important in a person's life, in the same way that you can use photos and other images.
- The person should first be asked to select the images that show something that is important to them.
- Note down why the image is important, why they selected it and what it means to them. Use prompt questions where necessary to draw out additional information.
- The images contained in the picture library can be copied and used to complete the person's picture resource.
